Frequently Asked Questions

Can I just turn up?

Yes, of course. FIX I.T. sessions are not classes. You can turn up at any point, you don't need to make an appointment and you can also join us virtually via Zoom

What should I bring?

Bring the equipment causing you trouble, together with its power lead or supply. Always bring your equipment along, we want to fix your problems there and then rather than discuss hypothetical solutions.

Why do you not ask for larger donations?

At a computer store you will pay heftily for a repair or be advised to buy a new computer but FIX I.T. is a non-profit initiative run by experts with the valued support of The Roy Fletcher Centre. We simply enjoy fixing I.T. issues, helping people and supporting the local community.

Can you help me remotely?

If you are unable to bring your equipment we can often help using remote assistance. You will need to know how to join us in our Zoom room and be able to 'share your screen' in order for us to help. Remote assistance is particularly useful for printing configuration and minor software issues.

What else might I need?

Make sure you are aware of any login details or passwords that you may need. Backing-up your data before your visit can save us a lot of time but we will always protect (or recover) your data and help you understand the different locations where you have stored it.
